## **Activities Conducted**

Students were divided into dedicated teams to ensure smooth planning, execution, and engagement throughout the outreach program.

Teaching Team: Focused on delivering educational content, including storytelling, basic academic topics, and introductory technical concepts.

Activity Team: Managed recreational segments such as drawing, music, and interactive games to keep the students engaged and enthusiastic.

Logistics & Coordination Team: Oversaw the schedule and ensured seamless interaction with the staff and students at Government Higher Primary School, Devarabisanahalli, contributing to the program's effective and organized execution.
