Report

Day 1- 27.10.2025

The first day of the bridge course consists of two sessions.

Session 1: Autonomy and Guidelines

The programme began with a detailed introduction to the academic curriculum and syllabus, aimed at giving students a clear and comprehensive understanding of the courses they will undertake. Dr. V. Asha, Head of the Department (HoD) of MCA, inaugurated the session with an insightful overview of the MCA Department. In her address, she highlighted the following key points:

1. Credit Allocation

 As an autonomous institution, the MCA program follows VTU guidelines for credit distribution.

2. Syllabus Framing Process

- The syllabus is formulated based on feedback from stakeholders such as students,
 alumni, parents, academic experts, and industry professionals.
- o A preliminary draft of the syllabus is prepared.
- o This draft undergoes review and refinement during the Board of Syllabus meeting.
- Finally, the Academic Council Meeting (ACM) is held, where the syllabus is approved and finalised.





Session 2: Library Resource Utilisation

The Library Orientation Programme for first-semester MCA students was conducted to familiarise them with the features and services of the college's Library and Information Centre.

Dr. Anitha S. Rai, Director of Library and Alumni Relations, commenced the session by demonstrating the online portal used for accessing various library resources. She outlined the wide range of facilities offered by the library, including its rules, regulations, and operating hours. The session also highlighted the library's extensive collection of books, project reports, research articles, journals, and magazines. Dr. Anitha S. Rai further explained the library's automated services, giving students a clear understanding of its streamlined and efficient operations.

Students were then introduced to the Digital Library and its digital repository, which provides access to syllabi, notes, and question papers. Detailed guidance was given on using institutional repositories for academic and research activities. Information regarding e-book downloads and access to daily newspaper clippings was also shared.

Overall, the session was highly informative and offered meaningful insights into the library's resources and services, greatly benefiting all participants.





Day 2 - 28.10.2025

There were five sessions on day 2 of the bridge course.

Session 1: Introduction to IPR and Design Thinking

The session was led by Dr. V. Agalya, Professor and Associate Head – R&D at NHCE, who introduced the concepts of Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) and Design Thinking. She began with an engaging activity by dividing the students into pairs—Partner A and Partner B. Each pair participated in an interactive exercise designed to highlight the importance of collaboration between customers and designers during product or model development. In this activity, the

"Customer" provided specific requirements of an invitation while the "Designer" created a model, illustrating how effective communication influences successful design outcomes.

To deepen the understanding, Dr. Agalya presented a video demonstration showcasing the connection between design processes and customer needs. She also shared real-world examples. Furthermore, she explained seven different types of Intellectual Property Rights, including patents, design rights, geographical indications, and others, emphasising their relevance in protecting innovation.

The session concluded by reinforcing the importance of creativity, innovation, and the core principles of design thinking.







Session 2: Placement Orientation - Guidelines

The session was conducted by Mr. Pradeep Kote, Senior Director – HRD, who introduced students to the various resources and support systems available for career planning, and development. He shared valuable guidance on resume building, interview preparation, and internship opportunities, all aimed at helping students transition smoothly into the professional world.

Mr. Pradeep Kote explained that placement preparation begins as early as the first year, with mandatory training that covers quantitative aptitude, logical reasoning, verbal ability, and soft skills. This structured approach ensures that students are thoroughly prepared for the placement process. Additionally, career counseling sessions are offered to help students identify suitable career paths that align with their strengths, academic performance, interests, and long-term aspirations.

The central objective is to nurture competent Engineers and Business Managers equipped with essential life skills—such as problem-solving, process re-engineering, and value creation. Mr. Pradeep Kote emphasised the importance of developing these skills, which extend beyond the standard academic curriculum.


He also provided insights into the recruitment and selection processes followed by various companies and highlighted the need for consistent participation in all placement-related activities.





Session 3: Ice Breaking Session

The fun-filled session was led by the FOSS Club students. They engaged the audience by encouraging them to introduce themselves creatively and share one unique fact about their background or interests. This helped the new batch interact comfortably and recognise common hobbies and strengths. The activity created an energetic atmosphere and reduced the initial hesitation among students.



Session 4: KSCST Projects and External Participation

The session was conducted by Dr. Arpana Prasad, Associate Professor, Department of MCA, who highlighted the various club activities offered within the department. She introduced students to a diverse range of extracurricular clubs and societies, encouraging them to participate actively to enhance their overall learning experience beyond academics.

Dr. Arpana also discussed the Karnataka State Council for Science and Technology (KSCST) project, emphasising its significance. She explained the procedures and guidelines for obtaining KSCST funding and outlined the expectations and responsibilities of students involved in these projects.





Session 5: Introduction to Student Clubs

The FOSS Club organised an orientation session for first-year students to introduce them to the club's mission, activities, and opportunities. The session opened with an overview of the Free and Open Source Software (FOSS) Club, highlighting its key objectives—promoting the use and development of open-source software, fostering a collaborative learning culture, and encouraging innovation and community-driven contributions. Students were briefed on the various activities conducted by the club, including workshops on programming and open-source tools, coding competitions, and expert talks by industry professionals. These initiatives are designed to strengthen technical skills, offer practical exposure, and promote teamwork and creativity.

The session also outlined the expectations from club members, emphasising active participation and a keen interest in learning. Freshers were encouraged to join the FOSS Club, with compelling reasons such as gaining hands-on technical expertise, building a strong portfolio through contributions to open-source repositories, and developing essential problem-solving and communication skills. The joining process was clearly explained, students were advised to attend meetings, register through official links, and stay updated through the club's social media platforms.



Day 3-29.10.2025

The Bridge Course on the third day included four sessions:

Session 1: Insights to NPTEL

The session was conducted by Dr. Vasumathi N. T., Associate Professor in the MCA Department, who provided a clear overview of online MOOC courses and the guidelines associated with them. She emphasised that completing the mandatory MOOC courses is a requirement for graduation and outlined the assessment pattern used for these courses.

Dr. Vasumathi also explained how MOOC courses are integrated into the Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE) component for both core and elective subjects. Additionally, she highlighted the importance of submitting NPTEL assignments on time and detailed the corresponding weightage allotted to these submissions.





Session 2: Introduction to IIC

Dr. Sujin Jose, Associate Professor and President, Institution's Innovation Council, conducted a session on the activities of the Institution's Innovation Council (IIC) and encouraged students to actively participate in its initiatives. He explained that the IIC is dedicated to helping students pursue their passions and think beyond conventional career paths.

The council focuses on fostering a strong Industry–Academia collaboration, enabling students to innovate, develop entrepreneurial mindsets, and strive for excellence. Through its various programs and guidance, the IIC supports students in achieving their goals and reaching the pinnacle of success.





Session 3: Ice Breaking Session

The second ice-breaking session involved a fun team-based activity where students worked in small groups to solve simple tasks or puzzles. This encouraged teamwork, collaboration, and

quick decision-making. The session helped them build confidence in interacting with peers and created a sense of belonging in the new environment.



Session 4: Placement Thoughts - Placed Students

The session continued with a placement talk, during which students who had secured positions in various companies shared their experiences and the challenges they encountered during the interview process. Mr. Anurag, Mr. Arpith, Mr. Sushanth, Mr. Sumit, and Mr. Niranth spoke about their individual journeys, discussing their involvement in research paper publications, their participation in organising and engaging with club activities, and the strategies they followed while preparing for placements.





Day 4 – 30.10.2025

Session 1: Innovations in Research Paper Publications

The session was conducted by Dr. Vinoth Kumar, Professor and Associate Head of R&D at NHCE, who provided an overview of the research initiatives undertaken at both the college and department levels. He encouraged students to develop research papers based on their project work and areas of technological interest. He also stressed the importance of filing patents and explained the procedure involved in the patent application process.

Dr. Vinoth Kumar highlighted the rapid advancements in technology and emphasised the value of publishing research papers in reputed IEEE and Scopus-indexed journals. He further encouraged

students to present their work at Scopus-indexed conferences and offered a brief outline of the steps required to participate in such events.



Session 2: Department Practices, Exam Protocol, and Dress Code

The session about the Department Practices, Exam Protocols, and Dress Code was delivered by Prof. S. P. Sreeja, Sr. Assistant Professor. She first highlighted the key department practices, emphasising the importance of adhering to class timings, maintaining punctuality, and submitting assignments and lab records within the stipulated deadlines. She encouraged students to actively participate in department-level events, seminars, workshops, and technical activities for their overall development. She also stressed the proper usage of laboratory facilities and computing resources, and the need to maintain discipline and academic integrity by avoiding malpractice. She also explained the guidelines to be followed during internal assessments and SEE examinations and outlined the procedures for re-registration, NSSR, NSAR, and the eligibility criteria for appearing in the SEE. In addition, she provided clear instructions regarding the dress

code to be followed during regular classes.





Session 3: Funding Opportunities for Startups

The session on "Funding Opportunities for Startups" was conducted by Dr. Mukul Manohar, Professor and Associate Head, QA & IIE. He emphasised the role of the NHCE Self-Funded Incubation Center in promoting innovation and entrepreneurship, aligning with the vision of Atma Nirbhar Bharat Abhiyan to build a self-reliant nation.

Dr. Mukul Manohar explained that the incubation center offers vital support to aspiring entrepreneurs, including ideation assistance, mentorship, access to funding opportunities, and state-of-the-art co-working facilities. By nurturing job creators rather than job seekers, the center effectively bridges the gap between academia and industry, serving as a launchpad for students, faculty, and external innovators to transform ideas into viable business ventures.

The session further highlighted the centre's structured programmes that equip innovators with essential skills, resources, and confidence. Dr. Mukul Manohar highlighted the centre's contribution toward fostering a society driven by innovation, self-reliance, and entrepreneurial development, ultimately supporting national economic growth and enhancing global progress.





Session 4: Student Activities

The FOSS Club students organised a series of activities designed to assess and enhance the participants' knowledge. Students took part enthusiastically, demonstrating high levels of energy and teamwork throughout the event. Their active involvement made the session both impactful and memorable for everyone present.

Debate – Students engaged in thoughtful debates on contemporary topics, showcasing strong critical thinking, communication, and reasoning abilities. The activity encouraged them to express their viewpoints confidently while maintaining respect for differing opinions.

Tech Quiz – A dynamic and fast-paced quiz that challenged students on topics related to technology, programming, and current innovations. Participants displayed quick thinking, and technical expertise as they competed to answer challenging questions and secure top scores.





Day 5-31.10.2025

Session 1: Mentoring Guidelines

The department provides a structured mentoring system that enables students to share their thoughts and concerns with faculty mentors assigned at the departmental level. Ms. Kalaivani A, Sr. Assistant Professor from the MCA Department, explained the mentoring process and informed students about the mentor–mentee allotment carried out at the beginning of the course.

Students were encouraged to discuss both academic and personal concerns with their mentors, who offered appropriate guidance and support to help them navigate their studies effectively. In cases where students required additional emotional or psychological assistance, mentors may refer them to the professional counsellors associated with the department for further support.



Session 2: Getting Started with IEEE Conferences

The session on "Getting Started with IEEE Conferences" was conducted by Dr. B Nithya Ramesh, who provided detailed guidance on the fundamentals of research paper writing. She explained how students can begin drafting their papers, with a special focus on the structure and formatting required for IEEE publications. Dr. Nithya also highlighted the importance of using reference management tools to organise citations accurately and efficiently. Additionally, she demonstrated effective techniques for searching reputable IEEE and Scopus-indexed articles suitable for different research domains. The session equipped students with the essential knowledge needed to confidently initiate and continue the research and publication process.





Session 3: Counselling Session

An orientation session on Counselling Support was conducted for first-semester MCA students by Ms. Anna Jogie, the Student Counsellor. The session began with a logo identification activity, highlighting the importance of being observant and aware of one's surroundings. Ms. Anna Jogie then explained the concept of counseling, addressing common myths and misconceptions associated with it. Through an engaging brain activity, she demonstrated that experiencing a wide range of emotions is completely normal. She also discussed the challenges commonly faced by individuals in this age group and emphasised the concerning statistic that India reports about the highest rates of depression, largely due to stigma and a lack of trust in counselling.

Ms. Anna Jogie further elaborated on how therapy and counselling can positively impact mental health and outlined their various benefits. She encouraged students to adopt and practice simple yet effective strategies for improving emotional well-being. The session concluded with an explanation of the counselling process available at the institution and a reminder of the importance of maintaining positivity in everyday activities.





Session 4: Student Activities

The FOSS Club students organised a series of fun activities, including word jumbles, sentence formation tasks, and a lie—truth reveal game. First-semester students participated enthusiastically, showcasing teamwork and creativity throughout the session. The activities were well received, creating an enjoyable and engaging experience for all participants.
