## **Brief Description of the Event**

The symposium featured competitions such as Algo Relay and Paper Presentation, where participants demonstrated their problem-solving skills, technical expertise, creativity, teamwork, and presentation abilities. The event encouraged collaborative learning and provided valuable exposure for students to enhance their communication, technical, and professional skills.

## **Inauguration and Welcome Address**

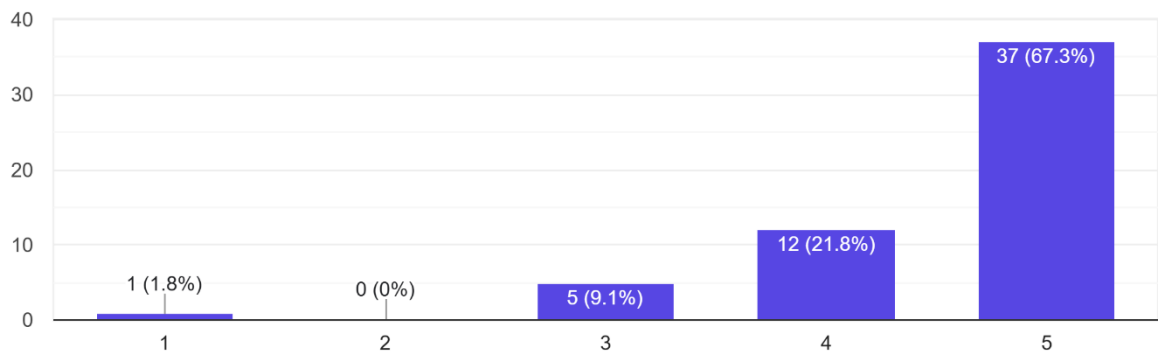
How would you rate the overall organization of YUKTHI V11?

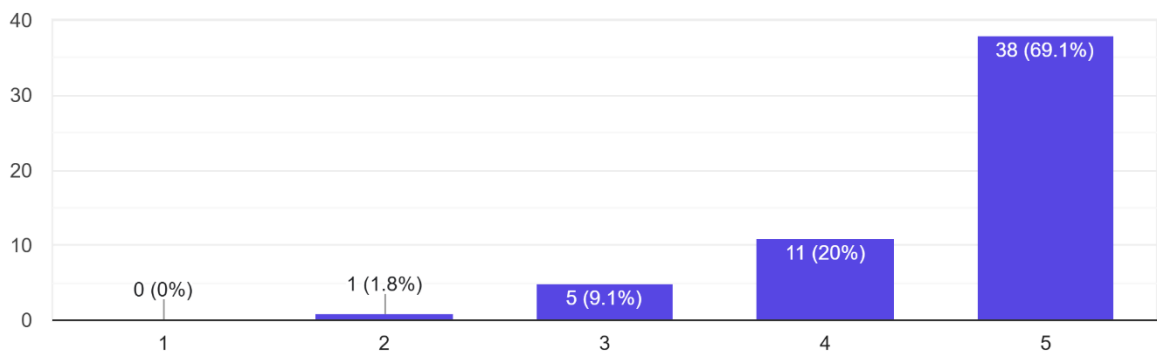
Did the event help you improve your problem-solving and presentation skills?

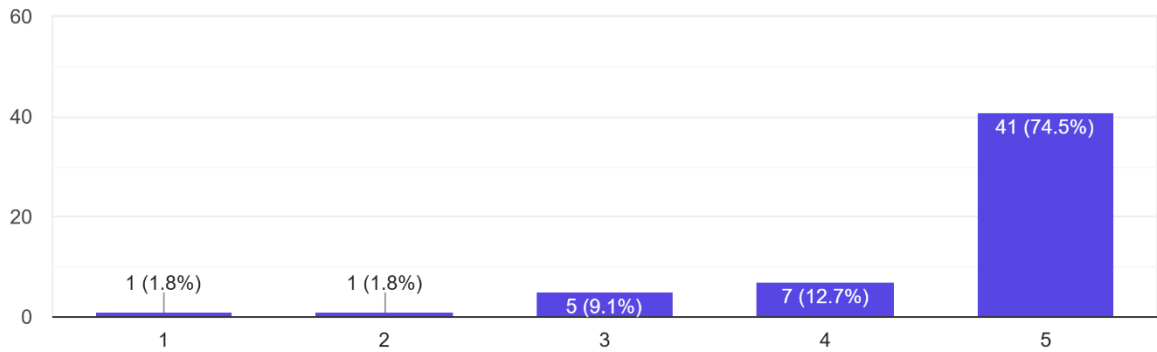
How informative and engaging were the events conducted during YUKTHI V11?

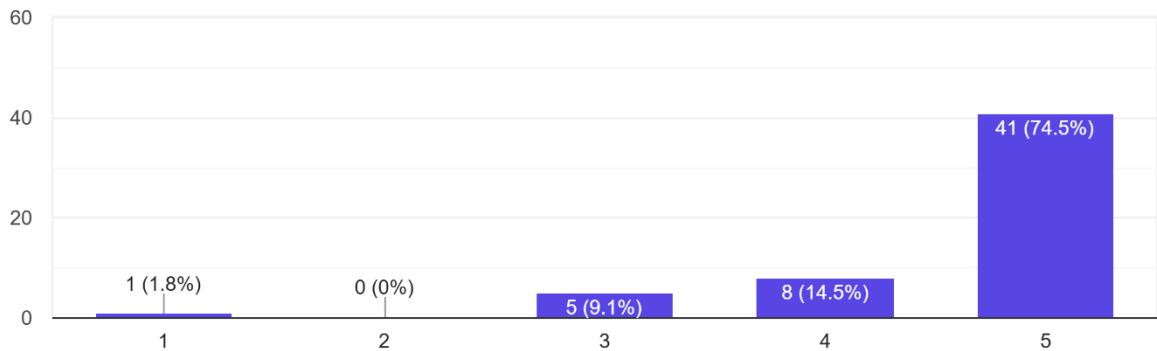


