From MCA Students

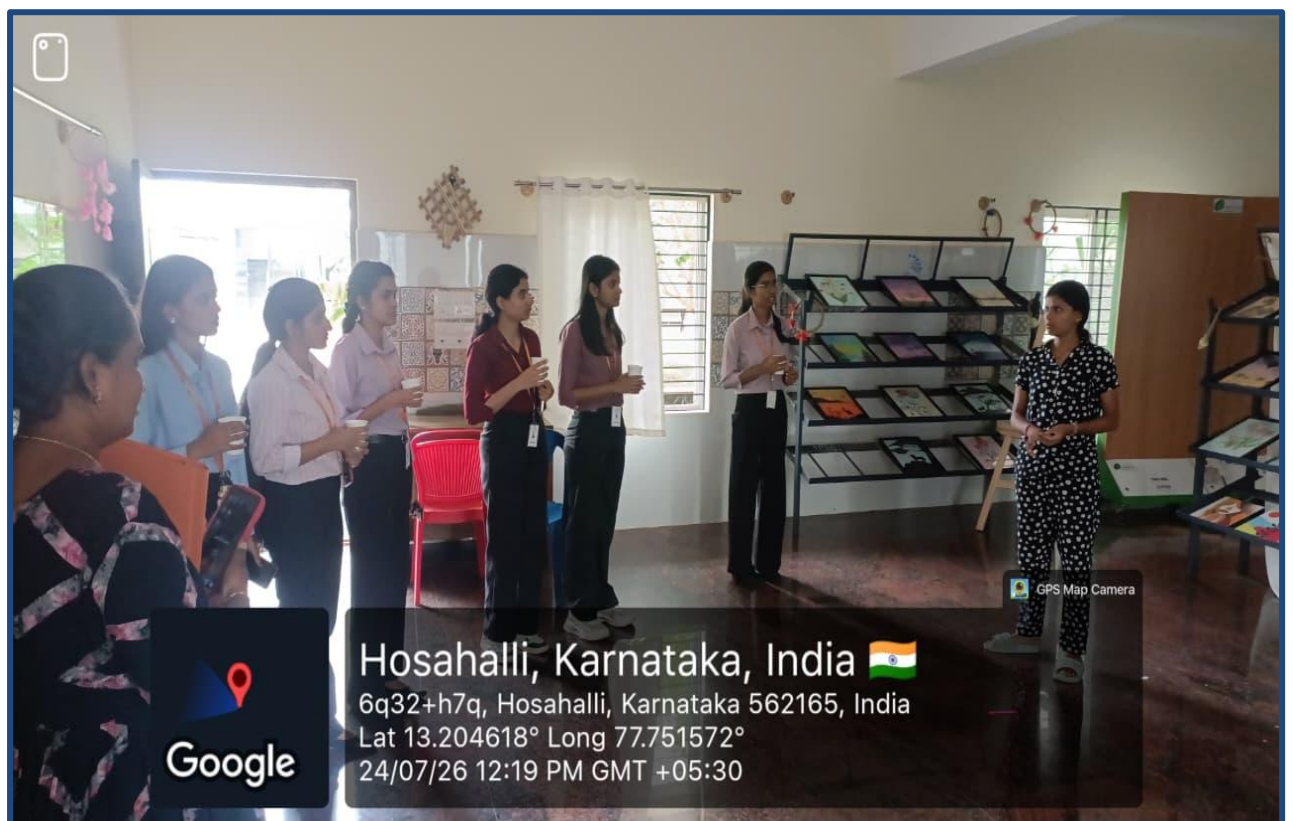
